

BY-LAWS

EAST HILLS BUSINESS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

Section I

The name of the organization shall be East Hills Business Association.

ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVE

The objective of the organization shall be to promote and develop the economic welfare of the East Hills area and its purpose shall be:

To promote and encourage community betterment of the Geistown Borough, Richland Township, Stonycreek Township and adjacent areas; to promote trade and commerce within the above described area; to cooperate and communicate between members and to advertise, encourage and promote business enterprises in said area; to support community projects and endeavors which will benefit said areas.

Section II

The corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members. Profits, if any, accruing to the corporation shall be placed in the surplus funds to be used for the furtherance of the objectives of the corporation as set forth above. No dividends shall be declared, paid or distributed.

Section III

If at any time the corporation shall be dissolved and there shall remain in its hands any property, money or securities, such property, money and securities shall be distributed to promote and encourage the community betterment of the East Hills area.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Section I

All individuals and organizations may become a member of the organization by paying the prescribed dues.

Section II

Membership in the organization is subject to revocation at any time, for cause, by a vote of the Officers of the organization.

ARTICLE IV – DUES

Section I

Annual membership dues are as follows:

- (1) Individual membership \$35.00 annually.
- (2) Corporate membership (up to 5 individuals) \$50.00 annually.

In no case shall membership dues be pro-rated during any dues year.

Section III

The membership year shall begin on the first day of January and end the last day of December each year.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

Section I

OFFICERS – The officers of the organization shall be as follows:

President
Vice-President
Secretary
Treasurer
Membership Relations Coordinator

The officers shall be elected in the December meeting each year by a vote of the attending membership. The term of office for all officers shall be for one (1) year beginning on January 1, or until their successors are elected.

The Secretary shall maintain accurate job descriptions for each officer.

Treasurer is required to add new officers to EHBA checking account within 30 days of appointment. Two Officer signatures are required at all times.

Section II

VACANCIES – Pre-term vacancies shall be filled by an appointment of the officers for the remainder of the unfinished term.

ARTICLE VI – MEETINGS

Section I

GROUP MEETINGS - Meetings of the organization shall be held the third Thursday of each month at noon.

Section II

OFFICER MEETINGS – Officer Meetings shall be held monthly no less than one day prior to the monthly group meeting.

Section III

Notice of all group meetings of the organization shall be sent via the member webpage by the Secretary one week prior to the meeting. A reminder shall be sent the Monday prior to the meeting.

Section IV

PROCEDURE – All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Parliamentary Law.
