Twenty-four (24) East Hills Business Association members and guests were present.

Opening Remarks

Due to the President's absence, the regular monthly meeting of the East Hills Business Association was called to order at 12:08pm by Vice-President Rodney Hatfield.

Treasurer's Report

Chris Fisher reported that the checking account balance was \$6,547.75 as of June 30, 2010. The Golf Outing fees and sponsorships were \$6,987; expenses totaled \$4,897.16; funds raised were \$2,089.84. The organization paid \$272.00 for the June luncheon, and \$210.39 for the June mixer. Donations were made to the following organizations:

The balance in the certificate of deposit is \$1,557.00. Rodney requested approval of the June treasurer's report; motion was made by Lauren Thomas, seconded by Jared Gorentz.
