Attendance

Twenty-nine (29) members and guests were present.

Opening Remarks

The regular monthly meeting of the East Hills Business Association was called to order at 12:03pm by President Kathy DePra.

Old Business

In March we gave a \$50 donation to Penn Highlands and received a very nice thank you letter from them for our donation.

New Business

Matt Cashdollar reminded everyone of the upcoming golf tournament, and asked that everyone take fliers to distribute. Announced we are looking for volunteers for the day of the event. We are looking for hole sponsors and door prize donations.

Kathy stressed the importance of everyone's support of the golf tournament and that the funds raised are distributed in support of local business and organizations throughout the community.

Kathy opened for discussion, implementing a \$10 late registration fee for memberships not renewed by March 1st starting with the 2013 registration year. The group as a whole agreed to implement the late fee.

April Donation Voting Results

Kathy spoke on the behalf of Matt DiFrancisco about the YMCA's annual children's program.

In a vote of 20 to 9, it was approved \$300 will be donated to the YMCA, which will enable 10 children to attend the program.
